The common management of these subsidiaries is in accordance with SBA guidelines and associated federal regulations (48 CFR 15.305 – Proposal Evaluation).

ADH has more than 400 staff in 12 strategic offices throughout the U.S. The Ahtna team's approach is to work collaboratively with project users, owners, and designers through all phases of design and construction.
